This collection of Relics comes from the Apostolate of Relics in Spain with a Certificate of Authenticity from Rome.

- A piece of bandage that Padre Pio used to cover his wounds.
- A cloth that touched the crystalized blood and serum of his stigmata.
- A piece of his glove when he was declared blessed Padre Pio.

For fifty years Padre Pio bore the stigmata of our Crucified Lord. Forty years after his death his body was exhumed and was found incorrupt.

At the present time many miracles are claimed as a result of the intercession of the greatest mystic of the last century, St. Padre Pio.
